- c. In addition to pay bands, D.A. as admissible under rules is also payable. Medical Allowance as prescribed by the State Government for its employees is admissible to University employees which, at present, is paid at a uniform rate of Rs 300/- per month. Border Compensatory Allowance and House Rent Allowance are also paid to the University employees. Limited residential accommodation at the University Campus is provided subject to availability.
- d. A copy of recent passport size photograph of the applicant, duly attested by a gazetted officer shall be pasted on the application form.
- e. Impersonation or submission of fabricated/tampered documents or making incorrect/false statement/s by a candidate will, in addition to debarring him/her permanently or for a specific period from any employment in the university, also render him/her liable to criminal prosecution.
