## **Admission Notice for B.Sc. (Nursing) 2017-18**

BGSB University has established three Nursing Colleges at Rajouri, Jammu and Kishtwar in a record time. Applications are invited from eligible women candidates for admission to the four-year B.Sc. (Nursing) programme.

Admission shall be made through a State-level Common Entrance Test followed by counseling / admission on the basis of merit obtained in the entrance test. The scheme of examination for the Entrance Test, procedure and modalities etc are available at the University website [www.bgsbuniversity.org](http://www.bgsbuniversity.org) Academic session shall commence from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2017 as per norms of Indian Nursing Council.

### **Eligibility for admission:**

- Should have completed 17 years of age at the time of admission or will attain this age on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission.
- Passed Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination from a recognized Board of School Education with Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English and scored minimum of 45% marks (40% for SC & ST Candidates).
- Applicants should be medically fit.

**Note: This academic programme is open for only women candidates.**

## Eligibility for admission:

- Should have completed 17 years at the time of admission or will attain this age on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission.
- Passed Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination from a recognized Board of School Education with Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English and scored minimum of 45% marks (40% for SC & ST Candidates).
- Applicants should be medically fit.

**Note: This academic programme is open for only women candidates.**

## Mode of Admission

Admission to B.Sc. Nursing programme shall be through Entrance Test that the University will conduct for the purpose. Selection will be based on the merit of candidates in the Test. The syllabus for the Test will be available at the University website [www.bgsbuniversity.org](http://www.bgsbuniversity.org) well before the Test. The actual date and venue of the Test will be notified separately through print and electronic media. In case the circumstances so warrant, the competent authority may authorize admissions on the basis of merit obtained in the qualifying examination.

The general standard of Entrance test shall be that of 12<sup>th</sup> class under the 10+2 scheme or an equivalent examination of an Indian University / Board. The duration of the test shall be for 02 hours. The Test shall be Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) based comprising of 100 questions as per the below mentioned distribution. There shall be no negative marking.

In case two or more candidates obtain the same marks in the Entrance Test, criteria to determine merit in the merit list shall be as under:

- Candidate obtaining higher marks in Biology in the Entrance Test figure higher in the merit list.
- In case marks obtained in Biology in the Entrance Test are also same, Candidate obtaining higher marks in Physics in the Entrance Test shall figure higher in the merit list.
- In case marks obtained by candidates in Entrance Test as well as Biology and Physics are the same, candidate who is senior in age shall figure higher in the merit list.

## **Reservation of Seats**

To fulfill obligations toward the socially disadvantaged classes the University has made special provision of reservation of seats in all teaching programmes including B.Sc. Nursing for admission of their children. For Nursing Colleges of the University Rajouri, seats have been reserved for them as per following breakup:

- Scheduled Tribes (ST) **09%**
- Scheduled Castes (SC) **08%**
- Other Backward Areas (OBA) **05%**
- Wards of Defence Service Personnel who are permanent residents of J&K State, and candidates belonging to weak and under-privileged classes as notified by the State vide latest SRO. (DS/UPC) **02%**

### **Nursing College Jammu / Kishtwar**

#### **General / Reserved (non-self financing)**

- Permanent residents of Jammu Province -(JPR)\* **25%**
- Scheduled Tribes (ST) **09%**
- Scheduled Castes (SC) **08%**
- Other Backward Areas (OBA) **05%**
- Wards of Defence Service Personnel who are permanent residents of J&K State, and candidates belonging to weak and under-privileged classes as notified by the State vide latest SRO. (DS/UPC) **02%**

## **\* Criteria for admission under JPR category**

- a) *Candidate is required to appear in the Entrance Test for BSc Nursing conducted by BGSBU or any other mode of admission as adopted by the University from time to time.*  
**and**
- b) *Candidate should hold valid "Permanent Resident Certificate" (PRC) of any district of Jammu province*  
**and**
- c) *Candidate should be eligible in terms of Wakf Act 2001 for consideration of admission under (JPR) category.*  
**and**
- d) *Admission shall be made strictly in order of merit obtained in the Entrance Test and availability of seats.*
- e) *Note: In case sufficient numbers of candidates are not available under JPR category, the seats shall be offered to such of the next candidate as per merit obtained in the Entrance Test, who is eligible in terms of (a) and (d) above.*
